Entry limits:
350 runs with jumps per day;
500 runs total per day

Move ups:
Move-ups, corrections & changes to entries will be accepted until October 16, 2019, at 6:00 PM PDT. Corrections & changes will not be made at the trial; no exceptions.

Move-ups from Saturday to Sunday for duplicated classes will be taken until the end of the last class on Saturday. Same-day move-ups will not be accepted. No exceptions.

Day of show entries:

Refunds:

- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if requested before or on the closing date. After the closing date, injured or ill handlers or injured, ill, or in-heat dogs will receive a refund, less a \$20 per dog handling fee. Verification from a doctor or vet may be requested.
- There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and/or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal.
- There will be no refunds for withdrawals requested on or after the first competition date listed in this premium, regardless of the reason.

Corrections and changes to entries will be accepted until the pre-trial move up deadline. Corrections and changes will not be made at the trial; no exceptions.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler Divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <http://nadac.com/afm/dogregfrm.asp> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course. No, food, toys, or clickers within 10 feet of the ring. Food or small toys can be in a secure container in pocket during a containerized trial.
- The sponsoring club/s will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas, and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor/owner assumes the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), Willamette Agility Group (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and Benton County (including its officers, directors, and members) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of exhibitor/owner's participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

Additionally:

- Checks will be held until the closing date. There will be a \$20 service charge for returned checks. Payment in full of entry fees and service charges shall be made by money order or cash before the first date of competition listed in this premium.
- The running order will be determined at the club's discretion. An attempt will be made to separate runs for handlers with more than one dog in a class.
- Exhibitors are advised that the Benton County Fairgrounds is public property. Other public and private events may occur within the fairgrounds complex on the same dates as this trial. To ensure the continued availability of this site, exhibitors must conduct themselves in a responsible and respectful manner. Exhibitors are responsible for the appropriate conduct of their guests, children, and dogs.
- The Fairgrounds is subject to Benton County's tobacco-free policy. This policy does not allow the use of tobacco products and electronic cigarettes on property owned or occupied by Benton County, including doorways, front porches or outdoor foyers, parking lots, parks, natural areas and the Fairgrounds.

ON-SITE RV CAMPING

All RV camping arrangements are handled by the Fairgrounds. Go to <https://www.bentoncountyfair.net/> and click on the link for Benton Oaks RV. Follow the instructions to reserve a space. You'll be asked to provide details about your camping rig, such as type, length, width, and amps. Disregard the statement in the reservation system about a 2 dog limit. The Fairgrounds is aware that our competitors may have more than 2 dogs. It is very important to clean up after your dogs and to make sure they're not disrupting other guests.

Most competitors prefer to camp at the lightpole spaces just north of the arena. This area is called the "C Loop". The reservation system does not allow you specifically choose C Loop spaces. To do so, you'll need to contact the Fairgrounds office at 541-766-6521 after you've completed the reservation process. Tell them you would like your space to be in the C Loop, and they will move you when space is available.

The Fairgrounds office will provide you with the RV camping map, passcodes for the restrooms, the wi-fi password, and contact information for the campground host. WAG will not be able to assist with RV camping matters.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

Address: 110 SW 53rd Street, Corvallis, Oregon

Take 1-5 to Exit 228 (Hwy 34 to Corvallis). As you enter Corvallis, Hwy. 34 becomes Harrison Blvd. Remain on Harrison through Corvallis to 53rd Street. Turn south (left) onto 53rd Street (Walnut Blvd. becomes 53rd at the light). Benton County Fairgrounds is approximately ¼ of a mile on the right.

Alternate route: As you approach Corvallis on Highway 34, do not cross the bridge into town, but turn LEFT at the light before the bridge; this takes you to the downtown bypass. Continue (west) to the light at 53rd St. (Bi-Mart will be on your left). Turn right (north) on to 53rd Street. The Fairgrounds is approximately ½ mile on the left.

Measurement:

See page 3 for information about which dogs need to be measured for this trial. The Trial Secretary will contact you if measurement is necessary for your dog/s. Permanent height card measurements will be available during the weekend.

“Containerized” trial:

This is a “containerized” trial. Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a Ziploc bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container may not be visible in the ring or within 10 feet of the ring. You may not indicate to your dog that you have this item on you (e.g., by patting your pocket). The container may not be removed from your pocket until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring. All food and toys must be contained at the trial and none may be left lying about loose. This policy has been implemented to reduce the possibility of dogs fighting over loose food or toys and to diminish the incidence of dogs dragging their handlers back to their crates.
